B-52 Brewery		
Taeda	Hazy IPA	6.5% ABV - A Hazy India Pale Ale brewed with Barley, Wheat, and Oats, and Cascade Hops then double dry-hopped with Idaho 7, Azacca, and Cashmere
Blackwater Draw Brewing Company		
Mulligan	Kölsch	5.25% ABV - Very clean, brilliant ale with noble hop flavor and aroma. Light to medium in body with a soft mouthfeel and a straw yellow or pale gold color, Kölsch has a spicy, herbal Noble hop bitterness that is medium to slightly assertive—less than a Pilsner, but not by much. A somewhat fruity or vinous (grapey from malts) quality and a crisp, dryish finish make up the rest of the flavor profile.

Blood of Brian Boru	Irish Red	6.3% ABV - 37 IBU - In honor of the 10th-century king who ended the Viking domination of Ireland. A traditional Irish Red with just the right malty sweetness. Sláinte!!!
Dirty Pants Lancelot	American Pale Ale	5.5% ABV - 35 IBU - This 1 is dedicated to dirty pants. Cheers sir. An American Pale ale brewed and dry hopped with Citra, El Dorado, an Australian Summer. Bring your swim gear.
Moat Juice	American style IPA	7% ABV - 55 IBU - Easy sippin IPA with Mosaic, Galaxy, Citra, and Azacca. Hops are the star here, and those used in the style tend to be American with an emphasis on herbal, piney, and/or fruity (especially citrusy) varieties.
Young Arthur V.3	Russian Imperial Stout	11.3% ABV - 100 IBU - Russian Imperial Stout, first brewed in England for Emperor Peter the Great of Russia, are higher in alcohol than traditional English Stouts. The best examples are full bodied, rich, and complex, and will often have flavors and aromas of dried fruit, coffee, and dark chocolate.

Big Hefe	German Style Hefeweizen	5.0% ABV - 14 IBU - A south German style of wheat beer (Weissbier) typically made with a ratio of 50 percent barley to 50 percent wheat. Sometimes the percentage of wheat is even higher. "Hefe" means "with yeast," hence the beer's unfiltered and cloudy appearance. The particular ale yeast used produces unique esters and phenols of banana and cloves with an often dry and tart edge, some spiciness, and notes of bubblegum or apples.
Watchtower Wit	Belgium Style Wheat Ale	5.0% ABV - 20 IBU - This Belgian White has a subtle aroma and taste of sweet orange peel and coriander

Bombshell Blonde	American Blonde Ale	5.25% ABV - 20 IBU - A rich, creamy golden colored ale fermented at a cool temperature to give a clean finish. Hints of yeasty bread and a touch of hops combine to make a beer that is truly more than the sum of its parts.

Huff Brewing Company

Huff Old 300 Dark Lager

4.8% ABV - Schwarzbier Dark Lager - Smooth on the palate, soul lifting, and refreshing with a dry finish, Schwarzbiers make a great alternative for the winter months, .especially when you're looking for a lighter beer, but one with depth of color and a bittersweet taste that might bring to mind coffee, cocoa, or licorice.

Huffmeister Lager

5.2% ABV - 16 IBU - Huffmeister's golden color and light aroma are graced by noble hops and a mellow sweetness to follow—all carried by this lager's light body and dry finish.

Spoetzi Brewery

Shiner Bock Dark Lager

4.5% ABV - Brewed with rich roasted barley malt and German specialty hops, this lightly hopped American-styled dark lager always goes down easy. Originally a seasonal beer, fans have demanded it year-round since 1973.

Shiner Light Blonde Light Lager

4.2% ABV - The folks at "the little brewery" in Shiner, TX (pop. 2,069), are proud of this refreshing, 99-calorie addition to the Spoetzi family of beers. It's brewed with the same handcrafted, small-batch pride you expect from Shiner, delivering a unique light beer.

5.3% ABV - 15 IBU - Czech Mex by Stesti Brewing Company is a Vienna Lager.

Texas Beer Company

6.0% ABV - A Texas style porter, rich and malty, yet extremely easy to drink. It blends chocolate and roasted barley with subtle notes of coffee malt, creating refreshing and delicious flavor profiles. This beer's dark body pays tribute to the fertile farmland of Taylor's Blacklands prairie.

Buckethead American IPA

8.98% ABV - Buckethead IPA is like riding a bucking bull, naked. Big buckets of hops give you a bitter and bold kick in the mouth that makes you feel alive. To up the intensity, we add four types of hops that are balanced by a light caramel malt sweetness.

Thirsty Goat Amber Red Ale

6.8% ABV - 30 IBU - Sweet, malty, and rich deep flavor with a spicy finish. American amber ale is named after the golden to amber color this American version of English pale ale exhibits. The color is derived from the use of caramel and crystal malt additions, which are roasted to provide amber beers with the color, body and flavor many beer fans have come to appreciate.
