"FrightStorming" sessions are extremely engaging for students—recommended for grades 3-6. Crantz's presentations utilize a multidimensional approach. First, he works with the students to generate a unique character, incorporating ideas from your students ... then the fun begins. Crantz will put their character into a story prompt and as a group, we'll brainstorm a whole story—often a whole world! Crantz incorporates his favorite plot tool—the twist! As a group, we will twist and turn our way through wild and crazy ideas, having fun all the way, with an end result that will have your students excited to write, create, and read!

FrightStorming sessions utilize many important Habits of Mind for kids, including: Persisting, Listening & Understanding with Empathy, Thinking Flexibly, Thinking about your Thinking, Questioning & Problem Posing, Thinking and Communicating with Clarity & Precision, Creating, Imagining, & Innovating, and Thinking Interdependently.

#### "FrightStorming" Classroom Visit Information

#### Each visit is typically 45 minutes and includes:

- Introduction about Culliver Crantz and FrightVision
- Brainstorming Session
  - We will create a character based off of your students' ideas
  - Culliver Crantz will provide a story prompt for their character
  - As a group, we will brainstorm the story, often creating a full world
- Students will also have some time at the end to ask Culliver Crantz questions
- *FrightVision* bookmarks for each of your students (mailed to you ahead of time)
- Printed Order Form for the school/students for discounted signed *FrightVision* books
- Picture of final whiteboard with story idea that the group generated (emailed after event)
- Curriculum guide for *The Cursed Coin* (*FrightVision* Book 1), which ties to common core standards and includes STEM activities (created by K-6 Curriculum Specialist).
