Envisioned in the Village's Comprehensive Plan since 2009, the Cross Plains Lions Club is leading the fundraising effort for a new pavilion to be built in Zander Park by 2026. It will become the prime gathering space and lasting signature destination for residents and visitors to our community and forever showcase your generosity in its design.

The streamside pavilion is the capstone to the multi-year H.M. Zander Park improvement project, and will provide a year-round hub for community activities, outdoor education, events, private functions, and local commerce. The proposed design was approved for construction in the Black Earth Creek floodplain based on outcomes from a feasibility study.

In 2022, a 501 (c)(3) partnership with Gateway to the Driftless was established to support the Lions Club Capital fundraising campaign. All donations are made to the Gateway to the Driftless, noting the project.
