3. Current Challenges

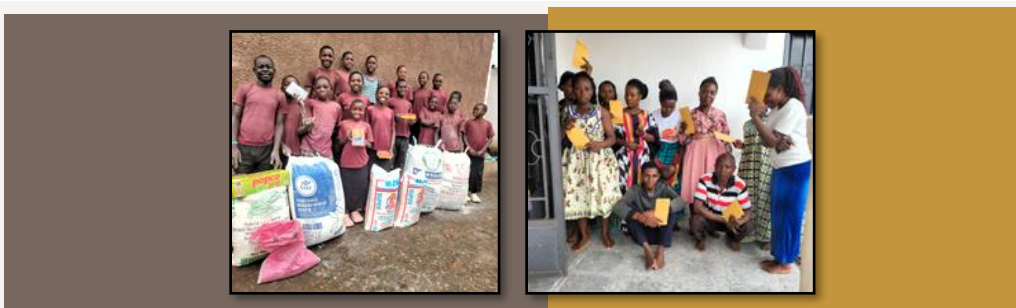
