2. Monthly Summary / Key Accomplishments

To strengthen accountability and ensure proper monitoring of construction materials, we employed a young man to oversee activities on-site. His responsibilities include recording the quantities of cement, bricks, and other construction materials used throughout the project. He serves as our on-site representative, providing regular oversight of the construction process. To enable him to carry out this role effectively, we rented accommodation for him near the project site and provided food for the duration of the construction period.

3. Current Challenges / Goals for the Next 90 Days

The remaining project funds will be used to continue construction of the children's room. The next phase of work includes completing the building structure, roofing, plastering, flooring, installation of doors and windows, and other finishing work required to make the room safe and suitable for the children. We remain committed to ensuring that the project is completed to a high standard and appreciate WeRemnant's continued support in improving the living conditions of mothers and children at Thyolo Prison.
