Who:	 It is important to apply directly with the school for any free or reduced price meals, especially those through the SNAP benefits program. Or, to apply for SNAP, go to www.connect.ct.gov and click "Am I Eligible?". Also, End Hunger CT! provides a SNAP eligibility screener (www.ctsnap.org) and call center (866-974-SNAP (7627)) to assist in determining eligibility. Families approved for SNAP are directly eligible to receive free meals at school. 	
What:	 When at school, meals for elementary students will be delivered to classrooms. The school also offers "Grab and Go" meals on the days children are at home for online learning. Students will receive a lunch for that day and a breakfast for the next day. 	
When / where:	"Grab and Go" meals can be picked up Monday through Friday between 10:00-10:45 a.m. behind the Morgan High School, 71 Killingworth Turnpike, Clinton.
