<b>Who:</b>	CT Residents. Residents from any town may go to any mobile food pantry. The closest pantries for Guilford residents are generally held in Clinton, East Haven and Hamden

<b>How:</b>	The distribution is a drive through pickup system, and participants must be able to get groceries into their own vehicles without assistance for everyone's safety. If that is not possible, the pantry directors request that clients send someone on their behalf or bring a household member for assistance.

<b>Physical address:</b> 117 Washington Ave Ste 17, North Haven, CT 06437		
<b>Who:</b>	North Branford and Northford low-income seniors and people with disabilities (those who have been deemed disabled by Social Security and are on Medicare). The client must meet these criteria: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Be a senior or person with disabilities</li> <li>2. Have a monthly income of \$1,500 or less</li> <li>3. Be homebound</li> </ol> Eligible residents of East Haven, North Branford, Branford and Guilford may also apply	
<b>What:</b>	A <u>one-time</u> resource of \$100 of free groceries and delivery. Volunteers do the shopping for the clients	
<b>When &amp; where:</b>	Once registered, the client would provide the grocery list to the office which would handle the shopping and delivery between 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. on a weekday	
<b>How:</b>	Registration required: Call for a required phone interview and form, Tom – <a href="mailto:tDavis@aoascc.org">tDavis@aoascc.org</a>

<b>Who:</b>	Senior residents of Greater New Haven including East Haven, Branford, and North Branford/Northford. Note: there is a waiting list.	
<b>What:</b>	Hot meals delivered. Meals can be prepared according to a doctor's recommendation.	
<b>When &amp; where:</b>	Deliveries to homes 5 days a week, Monday – Friday.	
<b>How:</b>	Apply/add name to waiting list. (203) 752-9919.

<b>What:</b>	Provides pre-packed groceries once every 30 days
<b>When &amp; where:</b>	Pick-ups are scheduled by appointment set between 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. on weekdays; the bags are pre-packed, labeled for the family and set outside for pickup. Town Hall Annex Building at 5 Linsley Street, North Haven
<b>How:</b>	The Pantry itself is closed temporarily, so the pick-up process is what is available now.
