Who:	Meals on Wheels/Family Fare Programs Eligibility - Adults who are 60+ and homebound. Now – Program is at capacity. There is a wait list. Referrals are required from a Department of Social Services worker for any individual who is homebound and in need.
What:	Delivers a balanced, nutritious, hot meal 5 days a week, M-F, to older homebound adults ages 60+; Meals can be prepared according to doctor's recommendation. No holiday deliveries. Meals are delivered on a service fee basis
