All funeral directors are ligally required to publish the Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors (because prices can vary.)

UNATTENDED FUNERAL

This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event, or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.

FEES YOU MUST PAY

For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot; for existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge several fees.

ADDITIONAL FUNERAL DIRECTOR PRODUCTS AND SERVICES

The funeral director may be able to supply a range of optional, additional products and services, or to arrange (on your behalf) for a third party to supply them. Examples includes:

Additional transfers of the deceased person's body (e.g. to their home, to a place of worship etc.) £195.00

Funeral officiant (eg. Celebrant, minister of religion etc.) £ POA

Services supplied outside of normal office hours $\,$ £ POA

The funeral director can give you a full list of what they can supply. They are likely to charge for these additional products and services, so you may choose to take care of some arrangements without their involvement, or you can use a different supplier.

- 1. This fee (which is sometimes called the interment (fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave.
- 2. In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for two doctors to sign the Medical Certificates for Cremation.
