

ATTENDED FUNERAL

£2100.00

This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.

- Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements
- Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death (normally within 15 miles of the funeral director's premises) into the funeral director's care
- Care of the deceased prior to the funeral. The deceased will be available for viewing either in the funeral home or the family home.
- At the date and time, you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle.

PLUS The cost of a Coffin to be added – starting from our basic flat lid coffin @ £440.00

UNATTENDED FUNERAL

This is a funeral service where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.

FEES YOU MUST PAY

For an Attended or Unattended burial funeral, the burial fee¹ **£249.00**

For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot; for an existing grave with a Memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee.
In addition, the cemetery may charge several other fees.

For an Attended cremation funeral, the cremation fee² **£688.00**

Plus doctor's fees for signing necessary paperwork **£164.00**

Please discuss any specific religious, belief-based and/or cultural requirements that you have with the funeral directors.

ADDITIONAL FUNERAL DIRECTOR PRODUCTS AND SERVICES

This funeral director may be able to supply a range of optional, additional products and services, or to arrange (on your behalf) for a third party to supply them.

Examples include:

- Additional mileage (price per mile) £2.00 per mile
- Additional transfers of the deceased person's body (e.g. to Their home, to a place of worship etc.) £POA
- Collection and delivery of ashes £30.00
- Embalming £160.00
- Funeral officiant (celebrant/minister) £POA
- Services supplied outside of normal office hours £POA

The funeral director can give you a full list of what they can supply. They are likely to charge for these additional products and services, so you may choose to take care of some arrangements without their involvement, or you can use a different supplier.

¹This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave.

²In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for two doctors to sign the Medical Certificates of Cremation.
