In 2025, the Jack Fay Award will be granted to a male and female student-athlete from Billerica Memorial High School. The class of 2025 has an abundance of talented athletes that will play Division I, II, or III athletics! But 2 of them have made a tremendous impact to their teammates and coaches alike. This year the 2025 Jack Fay Award is granted to Sara MacLeod and Dhaethmy "Judds" Dorival. Both student-athletes have been selected by their teammates as 3 sports captains of their respected teams and both students received the most nominations by the coaching staff at BMHS. This is a clear tribute to their character and impact they have had to their teams.

With that said, today is a day for Judds to be recognized as a great teammate and athlete. Most importantly, Judds has represented Billerica Memorial High School with the utmost integrity and sportsmanship that a school could expect. At his time Judds will continue his education at Assumption University. Over the past 4 years, Judds has participated in at least 90 varsity games in the sports of Football and indoor and outdoor track and field at BMHS. He has also earned MULTIPLE All-Conference Awards from the Merrimack Valley Conference in all 3 sports. Most recently, Judds earned the "Masters of Sports Award". As a track athlete, he recently earned a school record as a member of the 4x100 relay team as well as the 4x200 relay team.

Likewise, Sara was a three-sport captain of the soccer, basketball, and lacrosse teams. She has been described as a great teammate with a relentless work ethic! She takes great pride in all that she does. She has been recognized as one of the top athletes in all three sports as a first team All-Conference player. Sara has participated in over 160 varsity games during her time at BMHS. As a senior, she has earned the girl's lacrosse school record for total points in a career. Sara is also the recipient of the "Masters of Sports Award and the first to earn 15 varsity letters at BMHS! Sara will continue her education and athletics at Fairfield University as a member of the women's lacrosse team.

In today's athletic environment, it difficult to find multi-sport student athletes. It's with great pleasure to see 2 students such as Judds and Sara be awarded with the honor of the Jack Fay Award.
