CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

EARLY CHILDHOOD CLASSES

Two Year Old Movement (2-3 years)

This class is designed for our youngest dancers. The class will focus on basic movements and introduce the dancer to the classroom/studio setting. Dancers have the option of purchasing a costume and performing in the year end recital. Dancers must be two years old to enroll in class.

- Ballet shoes are recommended, black ballet shoes and tan tights are needed if performing in the Spring recital.

Tap and Pre-Ballet (3-5 years & 5-6 years)

This combo class introduces young dancers to the basics of tap and ballet using creative movement and imagery. Dancers build foundational skills and vocabulary while enjoying 25 minutes of each style. Students will perform both a tap and ballet routine in the spring recital.

- Leotard, tan tights (optional skirts/dance shorts). Black tap shoes and black leather ballet shoes. Hair pulled away from the face.

Hippity Hop (ages 4-6)

A fun, high-energy introduction to hip hop for young dancers. This 40-minute class focuses on basic movement, rhythm, and simple choreography to build coordination and confidence—all while having a blast! Dancers will perform one routine in the spring recital.

- Leggings/shorts, top/t-shirt and/or leotard. No loose clothing. Black jazz shoes

SCHOOL-AGE CLASSES

Tap and Jazz

Ages 7-9: Combo class includes 25 minutes each of tap and jazz with one routine per style performed in the spring recital. This combo class introduces dancers to the fundamentals of tap and jazz with a focus on musicality, rhythm, and proper technique.

Ages 10+ Tap and Jazz classes are offered separately (40 minutes each), with one recital routine per class.

- Tank/t-shirt, leggings/shorts, and or leotard. No loose clothing. Black tap and/or Black jazz shoes. Tan tights for recitals.

Hip Hop (ages 7-9 / ages 10+)

An energetic, athletic class that builds coordination and style through isolations and freestyle movement set to age-appropriate music. This 40-minute class will perform one hip hop routine in the spring recital.

- Leggings/shorts, top/t-shirt and/or leotard. No loose clothing. Black jazz shoes

Conditioning and Flexibility & Leaps and Turns

Designed to build strength, flexibility, and technical precision, this class focuses on muscle development, full-body stretching, and progressions for leaps and turns.

Note: This is a non-recital class.

- Leotard or dance top/shorts. Barefoot

SPECIALTY PROGRAMS

Pre Tumbling

A fun introduction to tumbling that builds coordination, strength, balance, and confidence through basic movement and beginner skills.

Tumbling Level I/II

Students will learn beginning tumbling skills, including cartwheels, handstands, somersaults, roundoffs, back bends, and more.

Tumbling Level III/IV

This class focuses on advanced tumbling skills for dance, including back handsprings, aerials, and more. Students should have a mastered cartwheel, back bend, and roundoff before enrolling. Tumbling classes do not perform in recitals.

No Limits Dance (Ages 5+)

This inclusive class is designed for dancers with development or physical disabilities. Students explore various dance styles—ballet, jazz, hip hop and lyrical—a supportive environment tailored to individual needs. The program promotes coordination, confidence, and social skills, with the option to perform in one recital shows. At BCFD, we celebrate all abilities and believe dance is truly more than just movement.

Our ballet school provides unmatched ballet training for the
Green Bay and Fox Valley area.

Ballet 360 by Barb's Centre for Dance provides a flexible training schedule for all ballet students while maintaining a high level of focus and is available at both our Green Bay and Fox Valley locations. Ballet 360 students can cross over between both locations. The name Ballet 360 suggests and promotes the idea that our ballet training encompasses and surrounds all other dance technique providing the core and foundation for a solid, well rounded dance education.

Dancers who are new to the Ballet 360 program will begin in an Intro to Ballet class and progress through our levels. Dancers who have previous ballet experience (not including a combination tap/pre ballet class) should consult the Front Desk to discuss level placement. All Ballet 360 dancers will receive an evaluation at the end of the Fall/Spring session.

All Ballet 360 classes perform in the year end Spring Recital.

TUITION

Please refer to the Tuition Schedule on page 8 for tuition rates and payment options. Tuition is due according to the published schedule; invoices will not be sent. Families can view their account information, including tuition balances and payment history, through the online Parent Portal.

A valid credit card is required to be saved to your account. If your tuition balance has not been paid by the scheduled due date, the credit card on file will be charged for one-half of the tuition balance on Friday, September 18, with the remaining balance automatically charged on Friday, January 8.

Accounts with outstanding tuition may result in the temporary suspension of a student's participation until the account is brought current. Students with outstanding balances will not be permitted to participate in the year-end recital.

Please note that registration fees, tuition, and costume fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.

GENERAL CONDUCT

COSTUMES FOR SPRING RECITAL

Costume ordering for Studio dancers will be held the week of Monday, October 26th. Studio dance classes are not held during this week. Costumes are ordered online via barbsdance.com. Information will be posted to the BCFD App for families mid October. Costumes usually cost between \$65–\$115. For combination classes, each student orders one costume and uses it for both routines (tap and pre-ballet, tap and jazz). Please see the acceptable dance attire section below for recital shoes and tights information. (See page 7 for additional Spring Recital information)

CLASS OBSERVATION

Parents may observe their child's classes during the scheduled observations times. Please see the attached calendar for exact dates. Observing is not permitted any other time. Solo, duet/trios and small groups do not apply, the last 5 minutes is reserved for observation.

Please see the attached calendar for class photo weeks. You will receive notification of the exact dates and times for your class(es). All classes are still held during these weeks.

WEATHER POLICY

If schools have been delayed/canceled, BCFD will determine by mid-afternoon if afternoon/evening classes will be held. Also, if school has not been canceled, but weather conditions have deteriorated during the day, BCFD reserves the right to cancel afternoon/evening classes.
