## SPIRIT OF THE HOLIDAYS, A CELEBRATION OF DANCE

Our 20th annual seasonal performance, "Spirit of the Holidays, A Celebration of Dance," will be held on Saturday, December 1, 2018 at 1:00pm and 6:30pm. The shows will be staged at the beautiful Meyer Theatre, downtown Green Bay. (Dress Rehearsal will also be held on Saturday, December 1st from 8:00 – 11:00am at the Meyer Theater.

Please arrive at 7:45am for dress rehearsal. We will start promptly at 8:00am and run the rehearsal in show order.) As is tradition, all profits generated by the shows and silent auction are donated to local charities. Our total charitable contribution from last year's Green Bay and Fox Valley locations was \$32,001.50. During the past 19 years the combined shows have raised over \$277,000 for local charitable organizations!

Our holiday shows feature our holiday dance ensembles along with our competition dance troupes, lines and teams. These young dancers will perform original tap, jazz, lyrical and ballet works to both traditional and contemporary holiday music. We will again be having a Silent Auction and Bake Sale. The second half of the show will feature a section from The Nutcracker presented by our Ballet 360 Academy.

## GREEN BAY HOLIDAY PARADE

The Green Bay Holiday Parade is Saturday November 17, 2018. The start time for the parade is 10:00am. We have not yet received our placement in the parade. Information will be available during the week of costume ordering, which will include our placement number, where to meet and where to pick up your child. Please remember: ALL STUDENTS ARE INVITED TO PARTICIPATE! Students will need to wear a red sweatshirt, black sweatpants (or any black pants), red BCFD winter hat (or any red or white hat) and red and white pom poms. "Barbs Centre for Dance" sweatshirts, winter hats, and red and white poms will be available in Dancewear Now starting Monday, October 29th.

As a reminder, all competition students are required to participate.

Please make sure that your child's sweatshirt and sweatpants are large enough to wear over winter coats/pants, as it is usually very cold. Again this year, we will be pulling a large wagon for younger students who wish to ride.

## COSTUME ORDERING

We will be ordering spring recital costumes the week of October 29th during your child's scheduled class time (regularly scheduled classes do not meet.) We order now so that costumes arrive in plenty of time for class photographs and recitals. Every student must have one parent attend; students do not dance or attend.

1. Conditioning/Flexibility/Leaps/Turns do not meet nor do they order costumes)
2. For Ballet 360 classes, one costume is ordered per student
3. For combination classes one costume is ordered per student and used for both class routines in recital.
4. 2 Year Old Movement, recital is optional, if you would like your child to participate please come to costume ordering during class time.
5. All other classes, one costume is ordered per student per class.

Costumes must be paid in full during your costume ordering time. Costumes usually cost between \$65-\$75. Credit and debit cards can be used to purchase costumes, but a 3% convenience fee will be added to your total. It is very important that we are able to order the costumes as quickly as possible. If we do not have your child's information and payment by Friday November 2nd, your costume will be subject to late fees. Any type of delay can push back our costume delivery dates. Please plan accordingly to order your child's costume during your child's regular class day and time.

MEASUREMENTS: Please take your child's measurements prior to ordering costumes. Bring them along to costume ordering and we will help guide you in choosing the correct size costume for your dancer.

Chest: \_\_\_\_\_ Waist: \_\_\_\_\_ Hips: \_\_\_\_\_ Girth \_\_\_\_\_

Girth measurement starts at right shoulder, down between the legs and up to the same shoulder. Please measure carefully and ask us if you have any questions.

All competition dancers will be ordering team, ballet and small group costumes online. Watch for a Team App notification soon!  
Solo and duo/trio costumes will remain at the studio.



## SPRING CELEBRATION OF DANCE

As a reminder, the dates for our 34th annual Spring Celebration of Dance are May 17-19, 2019. The recitals will again be held at the Meyer Theatre, downtown Green Bay. Please note: Dress Rehearsals will be held Tuesday May 14th and Wednesday, May 15th. We will have four recitals again this year. The dates and times are as follows:

- Recital 1 - Friday May 17th at 7:00pm
- Recital 2 - Saturday May 18th at 1:00pm
- Recital 3 - Saturday May 18th at 6:30pm
- Recital 4 - Sunday May 19th at 1:00pm

You will receive more detailed information regarding dress rehearsal, in which recital(s) your child/children will perform and ticket purchasing procedures.

## PARKING LOT SAFETY

Parents, please remember to use extra caution when dropping off your children for dance. Younger children should always be escorted into and out of the studio. Drivers, be careful when backing up and only use designated parking spots.
