


**1. Location:** There are three possible locations that will give a successful stimulation of the common peroneal nerve (dorsiflexion). The A position aligns with the fibula head, while **B** and **C** are aligned with a prominent lateral tendon. The reasons for choosing an alternative fitting position

2. **Cleaning:** Wash and dry the skin where the device will be



## 3<sup>B</sup>. Fitting:

Place the marker line the lateral/ outer/biceps femoris tendon below the crease of the knee.



**4. Turning On:** To turn on, use a short press of the 

button.




**5. Settings:** Use the ⊕ button to increase the setting and ⊖ button to decrease. Increase the setting until you get a rhythmic upwards and outwards movement of the foot.




## 3<sup>A</sup>. Fitting:

fitted.

Remove the film from the geko™ device and place the marker line ••• over the fibula head.



3°. Fitting: Place the marker line ▶▶●**∢** on the lateral/outer tendon just above the crease of the knee.



## **6.** Switching Off:

To turn it off, hold ⊖ button down for 3 seconds.



**7. Removing:** Remove carefully in one piece, to avoid damaging the skin.
