

WOODLOT TENDER

WT-24-04

Woodlot owner is seeking harvest Tender Bids for a property in the Canterbury, New Brunswick area (York County).

Total harvest area is approximately 51.1 hectares (126.3 acres) in size.

New road construction is not required. There are mapped watercourses and forested wetlands present. Contractors must follow all applicable regulations and all proper permits must be obtained prior to harvest.

The harvest area will be limited to two sections of the woodlot. Section A is to have all balsam fir, mature spruce, white birch, and aspens removed. Section B is a diameter-based cut, aimed at removing the mature and poor quality stems while creating proper conditions for the establishment of regeneration and future management.
