Specifications:

Length: 8'9" (>11 inch can produce 7'0" long for recovery logs)

Clear face: Perfect face (no knot)

Forks: not accepted

Straight crack: accepted but loss in clear faces

Delimbing: knots flush with log

Class B log: do not respect class A logs specs

VENEER: (11 inch +) at small end

Birch: 8'9", 9'6", 10'6" and 11'6"

Maple: 9'6", 10'6" and 11'6"

Possible pieces will be put aside to be
measured by an independant certified
veneer scaler
