Logs not responding to specs will be paid at 45 \$ / m3 roadside (class B logs)

Pieces declassified to pallet will be paid at 40\$ / m3 roadside

### Specifications:

**Length:** 8'9" (>11 inch can produce 7'0" long for recovery logs)

**Clear face:** Perfect face (no knot)

**Forks:** not accepted

**Straight crack:** accepted but loss in clear faces

**Delimbing:** knots flush with log

**VENEER:** (11 inch +) at small end

**Birch:** 8'9", 9'6", 10'6" and 11'6"

**Maple:** 9'6", 10'6" and 11'6"

Possible pieces will be put aside to be measured by an independent certified veneer scaler

**Class B log:** do not respect class A logs specs
