As we in darkness roam.

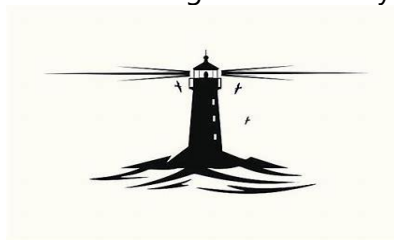
The danger lurks with hidden mines
