Luke 1:46-55

And Mary said, "My soul magnifies the Lord, ⁴⁷and my spirit rejoices in God my Savior, ⁴⁸for he has looked with favor on the lowliness of his servant. Surely, from now on all generations will call me blessed; ⁴⁹for the Mighty One has done great things for me, and holy is his name. ⁵⁰His mercy is for those who fear him from generation to generation. ⁵¹He has shown strength with his arm; he has scattered the proud in the thoughts of their hearts. ⁵²He has brought down the powerful from their thrones, and lifted up the lowly; ⁵³he has filled the hungry with good things, and sent the rich away empty. ⁵⁴He has helped his servant Israel, in remembrance of his mercy, ⁵⁵according to the promise he made to our ancestors,

to Abraham and to his descendants forever."

I had overheard my father and brothers telling stories about God. God would sometimes even choose a special person to receive a message from a divine messenger that would change the course of our history. I don't remember hearing of any women getting a divine message though, at least, not from someone outside of their own family. I guess Sarah and Abraham talked to angels together, but me, I was all alone when the angel appeared to me. I am not sure why

I was chosen though. I thought I was dreaming. What could God possibly want with me? I am a woman, I don't have any influence around here. I am getting ready to be married, and I will become the property of another man, another family. But the angel called me Favored one...God favors me! God is with me. I had no idea what to do with these words and I could not have imagined what kind of message this would be.

blaspheming God with this divine announcement. It's not an easy message to hear, though I guess there aren't many easy messages that God has come to announce. But the angel told me not to be afraid.

I am going to carry a miracle. I am still not sure how it is going to happen, but I am going to have a child who will grow into the savior of our world. I do find myself wondering about how God thought up bringing a Messiah, a royal king into the world as a baby, especially a family as lowly as ours. Most people don't know they have been chosen by God from birth. I find myself wondering whether or not I should worry about things like whether this baby will survive past his 5 year birthday, unlike so many children born in the world. Or if sickness will weaken him from his job here on earth. Knowing your baby is chosen I don't think will make it any easier when he cries in the middle of the night, or when he falls and scrapes his knee in Joseph's shop.

Joseph...how am I going to tell Joseph? I am frightened that I will be disowned. This news will likely disgrace my own family enough that they would not even take me back. I have to tell them, but this is going to be so hard. Be not afraid...be not afraid... The Angel told me not to be afraid, and now I understand. You see, I went to Joseph, and he already knew, and he's going to keep me anyway! We will walk this road together. I am so proud I have such an honorable husband who listens to God and listens to me. No woman could ask for more!

Nothing is impossible with God. That was the last thing the angel said to me. I believe that now, in ways I never even thought about before. God has come to an ordinary girl like me and changed my life. This promised one, whose kingdom will have no end, imagine what he is going to do for the rest of the world! Miracles are happening everywhere.


