

This time of year is often filled with waiting and preparation. Little ones wait with anticipation of hot chocolate, candy canes, and presents. 

Brad Arnold reported the general pledge offering continues to be lower than last year

The Consistory voted to hire Zachary Jackson as Grace's Sexton as soon as he meets the Axiom Service agreement of 400 hours.

There was discussion about lighting issues at Grace. An electrician should be contacted to replace batteries in some emergency light fixtures, replace a burned-out light in the parking lot, and check the sodium vapor light at the elevator entrance.

Craig Bixler reported changes are coming to PAL Lunch. Beginning November 1st PAL Lunch will transition to dine-in only. Any remaining meals will be available after 12:15 PM. A dish washer will be installed in several months. When there was a dishwasher available in the past, Grace needed 6 volunteers per meal. Currently, we need 4 to 5 per meal. The current hours are from 9 AM to approximately 1 PM. With the dishwasher in use and dine-in, the ending time will be closer to 1:15 to 1:30.

Pastor Amy reported the First Keystone Conference Gathering will be on November 22, 2025 at 9:30 AM on Zoom. Craig and Linda Bixler will be the delegates for this meeting.

The Outreach Committee reported gifts for teens and household items will be collected for New Hope Ministries in November. The mitten tree will be set up in the Gathering Place during December.

Pastor Amy reported:

- Bible study on Wednesdays has begun again. Join us in the parlor on Nov 12th at 12:30pm
- The sanctuary is open every Wednesday from 11am-12pm for quiet prayers.
- Fifth Sundays are special at Grace: Nov. 30th we will have a small potluck before worship in the gathering place. We will distribute Christmas packs to the neighbors like we did in June, inviting them to upcoming services at Grace.
- There will be a Blue Christmas (Longest Night) service on Dec. 20th.

- We are working on a joint Thanksgiving Eve service again. The service will be held here at Grace. We will have a joint service with Trinity Gettysburg, Trinity Hanover, and Grace. The service will be on Nov. 26th at 7pm.
- The offering for this service will be sent to God's Meal Barrel.

Vickie Arnold reported:

- The Second Saturday activity in December will be **Caroling and Cookies** beginning at 1 PM.
- As we move into 2026, we hope to have more ideas and opportunities for our Second Saturday events. We encourage all committees to share ideas for these Saturday gatherings as a way to share our faith and fellowship. Please reach out to us if you would like to sponsor or use the date for an event.
- Another new start for 2026 will be Committee Meeting templates which we are including for your review. We encourage you to look at these, share with your committees and provide us with feedback as you see fit. We anticipate these changing throughout the year as we start to use and find things we are missing. It may seem confusing or overwhelming at first but this is one small step we are taking towards more strategic planning in 2027 and beyond. Thanks in advance for your feedback.


