"Be the Church" Series Week 4 Forgive Often!

⁹"Pray then in this way: Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name. ¹⁰Your kingdom come. Your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. ¹¹Give us this day our daily bread. ¹²And forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors. ¹³And do not bring us to the time of trial but rescue us from the evil one. ¹⁴For if you forgive others their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you; ¹⁵but if you do not forgive others, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.

During my first year of ordained ministry, I was serving as the Associate Pastor of Christ Church UCC in Elizabethtown, Lancaster County, PA. I vividly recall the day of the West Nickel Mines Amish School shooting in Nickel Mines, Pennsylvania. The world watched as a 37-year-old gunman stormed the school and fatally shot five female students and wounded five more before turning his gun on himself and dying by suicide. The staff gathered around the TV in the church library watching the events of that morning unfold. Horrified does not come close to the feelings we shared. Nickel Mines would never be the same.

On the year anniversary of the shooting, the pastor appeared in my office and said, "We have to prepare to be interviewed by Channel 27 News who are on their way here for their Noon Program!" I responded, "What do they want to talk to us about?" "The Nickel Mine Shooting," she explained. We had about 15 minutes to come up with something intelligent yet theological to share on camera. The first thing that popped into our minds, **forgiveness!**

No matter the generation, culture has always struggled with forgiving. The Nickel Mines tragedy reminded our region of Pennsylvania about the value of forgiveness.

The Amish Community consoled the shooter's family as they comforted each other. Some even attended the gunman's funeral in support of those he left behind. Since the tragedy, people around the world have been inspired by the way the Amish expressed forgiveness toward the killer and his family. But while their acts of forgiveness were inspiring, they also caused a misperception that the Amish had quickly gotten over the tragedy.

Jesus spoke about loving our neighbors as we love ourselves. Although Love is the greatest commandant, when Christ taught us first disciples to pray, he spoke of forgiveness and not love. Such love is not possible without forgiveness of self and others. What is it that weighs on your heart today? Can you find a way to let go and let the power of forgiveness wash you clean?

PRAYER: God, help us to forgive self and others as often and freely as you unconditionally forgive each one of us. Amen.


