their theology – and we would still be one. One in Christ Jesus. With all the gifts that each person brings, we would do the work of discipleship and BE the church.

I love how Karen Georgia identifies change as a hurricane that makes her heartbeat faster. I would say that the same happens for me when faced with change. But, eventually, change is the catalyst God uses to continue speaking to the church and to each of us. Change is hard. Change is also necessary for anything to move forward. Grace is standing on the crossroads of change, and hopefully the path chosen will continue to unite us as one in Christ and with each other.


