

Transition Update

A few of you have been asking what Grace is doing to find a new pastor? The Transition Team is working hard at developing Town Hall conversations that will help members of Grace determine what they would like to have in their next called pastor. The next Town Hall will be on Sunday, June 23rd during the 10AM worship. We will be talking about change in the church.

Behind the scenes, many things have been happening to prepare Grace UCC for their next pastor. Because of the unusual circumstances for the leaving of our last minister, Transitional Pastor, Rev. Fred Young has suggested Grace put the following into action:

• Revamping of the Personnel Committee

(Creation of a committee job description, and an employee handbook)

• Creation of a Pastoral Relations Committee

(This team works as a liaison between the congregation and the pastor)

• Creation of a new Finance Committee

(We have a Co-Treasurer team and an Assistant Treasurer in place to hand our day-to-day financials as well as our investment accounts)

All of these teams have been put into place and have begun their work in helping Grace move forward. A team that is still in the initial planning stage is a **visitation team** that will assist the pastor in connecting with our homebound and infirm members. When a team is established, Pastor Fred will offer a few weeks of visitation training.

Outreach Committee Planned Activities for June

The Outreach Committee plans activities to help our community and locations beyond. Below are some upcoming activities:

May: Plan new dates for the Grace car show

June: collect items for Church World Service School Kits, assemble kits in July. Watch for announcements at the beginning of June.

August & September: collect hygiene items for men's and women's kits to be donated to the HACC Changing Lives Shelter, assemble kits in September

Church World Service School Kit Supplies:

- · One pair of blunt scissors removed from the package (rounded tip, only)
- · Three 70-page count spiral bound notebooks or notebooks totaling 200-210 pages (no loose-leaf or filler paper)
- · One 30-centimeter / 12" ruler
- · One hand-held pencil sharpener removed from the package
- · One large eraser (no pencil cap erasers)
- · Six new, unsharpened pencils with erasers (removed from packing and use a rubber band to hold the pencils together).
- · One box of 24 crayons (only 24)

One 12"x14" to 14"x17" finished size cotton or lightweight canvas bag with handles (Solid color or kid-friendly fabric, no logos, reusable shopping bags or backpacks) More details will follow about the school kits. Contact Craig Bixler for more information.

GRACE UCC COMMITTEES LOOKING FOR VOLUNTEERS CAN YOU HELP?

The Personnel Committee is responsible for filling paid staff positions to be approved by Consistory. The committee is presently tasked with the creation of a Grace UCC Employee Handbook, updating individual job descriptions and performance review procedures, all to be then approved by Consistory. The committee addresses issues which may arise with employees and conducts annual employee interviews.

The Hospitality Committee is intended to foster a welcoming climate within the church. They provide the snacks shared in the Gathering Place before and after Sunday worship. They support happenings in the church to bring people together with food and fellowship.

DEACON'S FUND OFFERING

During the month of June, the Deacon's Fund offering will be received. Blue and white envelopes labeled Deacon's Fund will be available at the entrances near the offering plates during the month of June for anyone who may wish to donate.

This fund was established to help members of Grace who may be temporarily in financial need due to illness, layoff, accident, etc. If a member is in need, he/she contacts the pastor who refers the need to the Deacon's Fund Committee. No names are mentioned. The members decide if assistance should be given. The aid is temporary and not ongoing. No funds go directly to individuals. For example, if the need is to help with an electric bill, Grace pays the electric bill through the Deacon's Fund. Thank you for considering donating to the Deacon's Fund.



There were 9 members present including Rev. Young and Amy Fawks. Len Bankert attended for Public Comment.

April 2024 Treasurer's Report:

Brad Arnold and Rick Boyer reported they have been in contact with our three investment firms. They are in the process of updating the authorized users and access to these finance accounts. They hope to be able to provide a full report at the next Consistory meeting.

Deacon's Fund offerings will be collected during the month of June.

Amy Fawks reported she has begun courses through the PAM (Pennsylvania Academy of Ministry) program from Lancaster Seminary (soon to be Moravian University). This begins my journey to becoming ordained in the UCC.

Jenn Weaver was approved to join the 2024 Consistory to replace Dan Trimmer.

Vickie Arnold reported the first Personnel Committee meeting will be May 20 at 1 PM. The search is continuing for two volunteers from the congregation.

Susan Dienes reported the By-laws Committee is currently discussing Article IV. The next Committee meeting will be May 22 at 6 PM.

Worship and Music report:

Vickie Arnold reported she is thankful for the kind members who have contributed to the snacks in the Gathering Place, to those who keep the beverages flowing and to Amy for announcing on the screen.

Outreach reported, during the month of April, the congregation donated \$735.00 to One Great Hour of Sharing. These funds will be sent to the UCC for mission work.

Pastor's Advisements:

Rev. Fred Young May 2024

Our first Town Hall on April 14th **Revisiting our Covenant** – was extremely successful. I was pleased with the turnout from the congregation and the participation within the conversation. The Transition Team took the feedback from this Town Hall and discussed it and determined that **the next Town Hall Conversation will take place on June 23, 2024** with the topic surrounding Change. The format of having this discussion in the midst of worship will remain for this next gathering.

Finance Committee

The Finance Committee has stepped up to take over after Grace's former Treasurer's resignation. Brad Arnold and Rick Boyer will serve as Co-Treasurers with Linda Bixler continuing as

Assistant Treasurer and check signer for the near future. The committee will be meeting soon to decide how to re-invest some of our funds.

Pastoral Relations

The first Pastoral Relations Committee meeting will be on Monday, May 20th. The members of this newly created team are Becky Boyer, Charlie Fennell and Jenn Weaver. During the first meeting the team will review the best practices for a Pastoral Relations Committee as suggested in the UCC handbook, *A Sure Foundation*, *Resources for the relationship between pastors and congregations*.

Other:

- I have been visiting our homebound members and offering communion to those wishing to receive on an on-going basis. I have temporary asked Amy Fawks to assist with visitation until a Care Team is up and running.
- Karen, Grace's church secretary has been working above and beyond in learning how to navigate Church Windows' Financial programs and reports. She has been working with Trinity's Financial Secretary, Karen Lentz and will continue to do so until both feel she is ready to completely take over this responsibility. When you see Karen, please thank her.

The Consistory spent considerable time discussing how to update Fellowship Hall.

Rev. Young will be attending the Penn Central conference on the 2nd Sunday in June. Rev. Young and the Consistory decided to have the communion in June on the 4th Sunday.
