

September Consistory Digest

There were 12 members in attendance including Pastor Amy Fawks, Brad Arnold, and Rick Boyer.

Treasurer's Report:

Rick Boyer reviewed the August Balance Sheet. Interest rates are falling; however, he will try to keep invested CDs at 4%.

Brad Arnold reported the Grace 2026 Budget is being prepared.

Vickie Arnold reported several people have been asked to serve on the 2026 Consistory to replace Glendon Ruhlman. To date, there have been no positive responses.

The Consistory approved changing the Administrative Assistant/Bookkeeper position to Office Manager.

Trustees:

- Tim Hagarman was contacted for a quote to replace and repair the heat tapes in the building's downspouts and to replace a rusted electrical conduit on the rear of the Education Wing. Tim quoted \$500 for each job.
- Contacted Structure Perfect to get a quote to inspect all vinyl windows on the Education Wing for needed repairs. Some windows have aluminum trim pulling loose.
- The contact list for afterhours alarms was updated at WFX. Jenn Weaver, Craig Bixler, Susan Dienes, and David Fawks will be called in this order.
- Possible cement repair around front entrance steps to the Education Wing.
- The downspout drain to the left of the front entrance to the Education Wing shows blockage. A quote should be gotten to clean it out.
- The frame to the parsonage garage side door has rotted. A quote should be obtained to repair the door frame and replace the door.

Brad Arnold has resigned from the Property Committee for the present time.

Grace has a lot of old pianos. Christian Keller recommended keeping the two pianos on the first floor. He will get a quote to have all the other old pianos removed.

Vickie Arnold reported we will be returning to our signup sheet in the Gathering Place for Sunday snacks.

Jenn Weaver reported Linda Bixler and Joleen Fennell are trying to find more volunteers to help with children's Sunday School.

CONNECTIONS:

- Made many phone calls (and many texts) to congregation members to check in
- Made 8 visits.
- Sent letters to families inviting them to the 5th Sundays are Special at Grace—blessings of the backpacks

SPECIAL WORSHIP:

- We had our 5th Sundays are Special at Grace on Aug 31st. We had a continental potluck breakfast out in the parking lot for outdoor worship along with Blessing of the Backpacks. We blessed 19 crosses and backpacks.
- On my Sunday off, I attended Zion UCC in Arndtsville (my advisor's church) to participate in worship and blessing of the backpacks on Aug 17th.

CONTINUING EDUCATION:

- I begin my 9th and 10th courses, September 3rd and 4th through October 8th and 9th.
- I continue to have conversations and meetings with my Advisor, Rev. Heather Kurtz
- I continue to meet with my discernment team here at Grace.
- I took a tour of Lancaster Seminary (now Moravian University) and participated in their Wednesday noon worship.
- I've joined a community of practice with other pastors throughout the state.

OTHER:


- I continue to reach out and make connections with the community and other local pastors.
- Karen and I attended a Community Symposium on September 4th regarding Food Insecurities. The hope is that we will get more information and create stronger community connections so that we might be able to help more when people call the church asking for money.
- Manger People disposal—worship and music voted to dispose of the broken manger people stored in the shed.
- Karen's office has been moved around after our safety discussion last month. We are waiting on an estimate to put the excess cords into a "box" (for cord protection and people protection), and also a quote for a new computer for Karen and a laptop for me. Both are too old to accommodate the move to Window 11 and Windows 10 will no longer be "serviced" after October. There is plenty in the budget for this year to accommodate those tech needs.
- The security system monitors have been moved and repaired so that Karen and I both have functional monitors.

The Consistory approved a gift for Pastor Fred Young and his wife Kara for his service to Grace for the past year and a half.

Jenn Weaver, Rebecca Boyer, and Linda Bixler met to plan a "thank you" for Rev. Fred Young, his wife Kara, and the congregation of Trinity UCC, Gettysburg. They proposed holding a brunch between Trinity's October 12th services. Jenn will contact Jane Malone at Trinity to see if that date is OK. Grace members may be asked to donate some baked items for the event.
