### **Grace Devotion**

#### Week of October 13, 2024

As he was setting out on a journey, a man ran up and knelt before him, and asked him, "Good Teacher, what must I do to inherit eternal life?" <sup>18</sup>Jesus said to him, "Why do you call me good? No one is good but God alone. <sup>19</sup>You know the commandments: 'You shall not murder; You shall not commit adultery; You shall not steal; You shall not bear false witness; You shall not defraud; Honor your father and mother." <sup>20</sup>He said to him, "Teacher, I have kept all these since my youth." <sup>21</sup>Jesus, looking at him, loved him and said, "You lack one thing; go, sell what you own, and give the money to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven; then come, follow me." Mark 10:17-21

Our lives as followers of Christ are about choices. It is true that how we choose to live out our faith, cannot compare to the challenge Jesus placed in front of the young man from Mark's account. But what Christ asked of this seeker is what we often strive for: living a life that is less about keeping the law and more about living the Gospel. Even though the man in this story walked away from his Teacher, Jesus loved him. And to love him, he had to know him, recognizing in him the whole journey of life which had already been his, and quickly assessing what he might be capable of next. Jesus loves us too. Mother Teresa sums up such love when she asks:

Are we helping the poor, the lonely, and the oppressed? People want to see Christ in others.

Therefore, we must love Christ with undivided love until it hurts. It must be a total surrender, a total conviction that nothing separates us from the love of Christ.

We belong to Christ.

There is another part to the rich man's problem. He is only worried about *his* eternal life without concern for that of another's. He is incapable of recognizing that abundance could be found outside of his own wealth. To him, the value of his life is defined by his stuff and not by the presence of Christ. If we belong to Christ as Mother Teresa suggests, this man has missed the mark completely.


Knowing the riches of this young man, Jesus still told him, "You lack one thing!" But the issue of lack takes on a particular meaning in this story — it is that which prevents us from a full expression of faith. What keeps you from being the follower, the disciple, the believer, the witness God wants and needs you to be? This is a terribly hard question to answer, but I want you to consider it right now. How might you finish the sentence:


