The Parable of the Lost Sheep

15 Now all the tax collectors and sinners were coming near to listen to him.² And the Pharisees and the scribes were grumbling and saying, “This fellow welcomes sinners and eats with them.”³ So he told them this parable: ⁴“Which one of you, having a hundred sheep and losing one of them, does not leave the ninety-nine in the wilderness and go after the one that is lost until he finds it?⁵ And when he has found it, he lays it on his shoulders and rejoices. ⁶And when he comes home, he calls together his friends and neighbors, saying to them, ‘Rejoice with me, for I have found my lost sheep.’⁷ Just so, I tell you, there will be more joy in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons who need no repentance.

The Parable of the Lost Coin

⁸“Or what woman having ten silver coins, if she loses one of them, does not light a lamp, sweep the house, and search carefully until she finds it?⁹ And when she has found it, she calls together her friends and neighbors, saying, ‘Rejoice with me, for I have found the coin that I had lost.’¹⁰ Just so, I tell you, there is joy in the presence of the angels of God over one sinner who repents.”

Dear Friends,

In today’s Gospel, Luke 15, Jesus shares two parables. The first story is about a shepherd leaving his 99 sheep behind to go find the missing one that wandered off. The second story tells about a woman who turns her whole house upside down to find a missing coin. In both stories, there is a huge celebration when the lost is found. We all have times when we feel like the sheep who wandered away—times when we felt overlooked or forgotten. But, Jesus reminds us that God doesn’t just notice us that we are missing, God comes looking for us. God searches for each of us without ever giving up. That means, no matter how lost we feel, God’s grace can reach us. We are not meant to find our own way back—it is about God who guides us and says “I’m so glad you are home!”

This week, if you feel a little weary, a little scattered, a little lost, hold on to this truth: God knows exactly where you are, and exactly who you are, and will stay with you until you are safely home.

Prayer: Loving and Gracious God, Thank You for never giving up on us. When we wander away, You search for us and lead us back. When we are lost, You find us. When we are alone, You remind us that we are Yours. Help us rest in the joy of being found and loved by You. Amen
