

Week of June 1st

As we look to the scripture this week, we know that Jesus' time is short. He is about to be betrayed and in those moments, He doesn't ask for strength. He doesn't ask for rescue. He prays for us! In John 17, Jesus prays not only for His disciples that day, but for all of us—those who would come along after that time and would become believers through their message. He prays that we “may all be one...so that the world may believe.” He prays for you...for me...for every single person who has come to faith through the testimony of another. This prayer is a prayer of unity—that everyone become one heart and mind. It is a unity that begins and ends with love. One heart, One mind, and One spirit. We are called to center ourselves in Christ’s love—in a way that makes our differences and our divisions fade away. We are meant to live as a people who are connected and belong. Our diversity is what makes each of us special to God and to one another. We embrace our differences in a way that we can be in communion with God and with each other. Jesus ends this prayer with “I have made your very being known to them—So that your love for me Might be in them.” This is the most important part of this prayer. A prayer for love that unites us and love that reveals God in us to all the world.

A prayer for each of us today: *Loving God, we are committed to showing love, Your love, to all we meet. Use each of us so that the world may come to believe. Make us one in love and purpose. In Jesus' name we pray, Amen.*


