

# Grace Devotion

**Week of September 7, 2025**

**18** The word that came to Jeremiah from the Lord: **2** “Come, go down to the potter’s house, and there I will let you hear my words.” **3** So I went down to the potter’s house, and there he was working at his wheel. **4** The vessel he was making of clay was spoiled in the potter’s hand, and he reworked it into another vessel, as seemed good to him. **5** Then the word of the Lord came to me: **6** Can I not do with you, O house of Israel, just as this potter has done? says the Lord. Just like the clay in the potter’s hand, so are you in my hand, O house of Israel. **Jeremiah 18:1-6 (NRSVUE)**

Sending you warm greetings and peace today,

I love the imagery in this scripture. I can just picture the potter, steady and focused, working the clay ever so gently. The wheel spinning beneath the potter’s hands—sometimes slowly, and sometimes fast enough to change the shape completely. With each press and touch, the clay begins to respond. It doesn’t look like much at first, but something beautiful is being formed. We are just like that piece of clay. There are times when we have made some poor decisions and we need to be remade, reworked, or transformed, into something new. Slight pressure applied so that we might see the changes we need to make. There are times when our changes happen so slowly, imperceptible changes, until one day we are able to see things differently—find new purposes in places we didn’t have one before. Then, there are times when the changes happen fast—situations we’ve experienced, people we have interacted with. We become changed, remade, and called to do things we never thought possible. Most times in life, it is difficult to see the potter’s work in the moment. When we take a step back, or reflect on all that’s happened, we can see the changes, the ways that we’ve been reworked into something great. Even still, the shaping continues. Even now, God’s hands are on us—guiding us, steadyng us. We don’t always know what we are becoming, but we trust that God sees the whole picture. The Potter isn’t rushed and we are not forgotten on the wheel. I hope that you can feel God’s presence close to you this week. Know that even now, you are still being made and reshaped into something beautiful.

**Prayer:** Loving God, We come to You today, knowing how You have impacted our lives. Help us to be present in the moments, recognizing when You call us to change and be present in situations when we would not normally. Guide us to be Your malleable clay—for our hearts to be vulnerable, our eyes to be open, and our hands to be outstretched in ways to serve, to welcome, and to love. Keep shaping us God, even when it is hard, even when we push back. Keep working with us until we begin to look a little more like love, a little more like You. Amen




