

# Grace Devotion

**Week of June 29, 2025**

*“<sup>5</sup> Whatever house you enter, first say, ‘Peace to this house!’ <sup>6</sup> And if a person of peace is there, your peace will rest on that person, but if not, it will return to you.”* John 10:5-6 (NRSVUE)

When Jesus sent His followers out into the world, He didn’t just send them with instructions—He sent them with peace. He sent them with the deep peace that comes from God’s presence and grace.

He told them to offer peace freely to every house they entered. Some would welcome it, and others might not. The peace, though, never disappeared. If it wasn’t accepted, Jesus said, “it will return to you.” What a beautiful promise! God’s peace is never wasted—never gone. When you offer grace, kindness, or a word of comfort (even if it isn’t received the way you wanted) God reminds us that nothing is lost.

It might be more challenging now to go from house to house, but every time you speak with a neighbor, call a friend, or say a prayer for someone else, you are sharing God’s peace. Even in the quiet moments, your very life is a testimony to God’s goodness and faithfulness.

You carry the grace of Christ with you. When you offer that grace aloud, in prayer, or even in spirit, you are continuing the ministry Jesus gave His disciples long ago. Where it is received or not, God’s peace always remains—returning to rest with you until the next time you share God’s peace with others.

**Prayer:** God of peace, help me remember that I am the giver of Your grace. Let my words and my presence bring hope, comfort, and love to those I meet, even in simple ways. When the peace I try to share with others seems unnoticed or unrewarded, remind me that Your peace always returns to me. Thank you, Lord, for Your constant presence in my life. Amen.






