Operation Gateway – The Department of Defense will be providing an opportunity for individuals to obtain free general medical, dental, and optometry services on a first-come, first-serve basis. This NO COST medical service will be offered at the Laughlin Health Building on Morehead State’s campus from July 12 to July 19, 2021, with hours 8AM to 4PM on most of these days.

Operation Gateway offers these highly qualified and experienced doctors an opportunity to actively harness mobilization skills, a vital asset to the military, as well as offering much needed medical care to citizens of Gateway Area Development District (GAAD)’s five-county service region: Bath, Menifee, Montgomery, Morgan, and Rowan.

Although the event is targeted to ensure uninsured or underinsured Kentuckians have an opportunity to obtain the medical services they need, ALL individuals are welcome and encouraged to attend if they are in need of medical, dental, or vision care.
