

Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 130
Bond Election Fact Sheet

Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 130 (the “District”) is holding a Bond Election on Tuesday, November 4, 2025, to obtain voter approval for the District to issue bonds in the maximum amount of \$15,000,000.

The District was created in 1982 for the purpose of providing water, sanitary sewer, and drainage facilities to the residents and businesses inside its boundaries. The District encompasses 767 acres of land and includes the subdivisions of Copperbrook, Westlands, and Hanover. Water and sanitary sewer service is provided to approximately 681 customers.

To provide water and sanitary sewer services, the District constructed, owns, and operates the following facilities (the “Service Facilities”):

- Water Plant
- Off-site Well
- Wastewater Treatment Plant
- Offsite Lift Station
- On-site Lift Station

Because the Service Facilities were constructed over 40 years ago, they are now in need of repair and, in some cases, entire replacement.

The District is seeking voter approval to issue bonds in the maximum amount of \$15,000,000 over the next 5 to 10 years to repair or replace the Service Facilities. The Bonds will be used periodically when needed for major capital outlays that cannot be funded through maintenance tax and/or water and sewer revenue.

Election Day and Early Voting
