## Seasonal Color

## Irrigation Updates

Winter can be challenging for irrigation systems, even when they're not in use. Cold temperatures, frost, and fluctuating weather can lead to leaks, broken components, or water loss. To protect your system and keep your landscape healthy, our teams continue performing regular inspections and assessments throughout the season.

These proactive checks allow us to identify potential issues early, make necessary adjustments, and ensure your irrigation system is ready for the upcoming growing season. ## Pre-Emergent Applications

Effective weed control begins early in the season. Pre-emergent applications play a key role by preventing many common weeds from germinating, helping your turf and planting beds stay healthier, thicker, and more attractive before weeds have a chance to take hold.

If your contract includes pre-emergent services, we will continue applying spring pre-emergent treatments throughout March, April, and May as ground temperatures and weather conditions allow. These applications are paired with seasonal fertilizers to support strong root development and promote healthy growth as the season progresses.
