JOHN W. MELONE CEMETERY

This cemetery is located about one mile above the McMullen Post Office, bordering the Dogwood Valley road, off St. Rt. 637 in Greene County, Virginia It is about 50' x 100', and contains 26 graves. Only ten of these have marke John W. Movers May 19, 1877-Sept. 2, 1927 Virginia N. Piper Oct. 2, 1852-Feb. 6, 1936 W. W. Piper Feb. 14, 1850-Mar. 12, 1928 "An honest man is the noblest work of God." James N. Piper Jan. 29, 1871-Feb. 4, 1919 "Gone but not Forgotten."

It is known that Marcellus Runkle's parents, Bezaleel Runkle and Mary E. McMullen, are buried in this cemetery, although the exact graves cannot be identified.

JOHN MCMULLEN CEMETERY

This cemetery is located about two miles off St. Rt. 637, northwest of South River Church, on the farm now owned by Lieut. Taylor, formerly owned by L. W. Breeden and previously owned by McMullen families for many years.

Apparently there are about 30 graves in this 45' x 55' cemetery. Only five graves have markers. The remaining 25 were identified by field rocks or sunken ground. Some of these unmarked graves could be slaves.

J. NEAL MCMULLEN CEMETERY

The McMullen cemetery is located on South River off routes 637 and 638 in Greene County, Virginia.

It is on the farm now owned by Charles and Jessie McMullen Walter, and formerly owned by Mr. & Mrs. J. Neal McMullen, parents of Mrs. Walter.

The size of the cemetery is about 18' x 24'. It contains ten graves.

GIBBS FAMILY CEMETERY

The Gibbs cemetery is located off St. Rt. 637, near South River Church, in the Stanardsville District, in Greene County, Virginia. It is on the farm now owned by T. M. Shelton, formerly the home of Mr. Geo. Ed. Gibbs and later his son, Mr. J. Frank Gibbs. The size of the cemetery is about 18' x 24' and is enclosed by a wire fence.

The cemetery contains seven graves, and is kept in good condition.
