CHAPMAN CEMETERY

The Chapman Cemetery is located on Chapman Mountain Circle, 1/2 mile west of the junction of Virginia Routes 604 and 633 in the Riverdale Subdivision of Greene County. The rectangular enclosure is fenced with a 3 foot high stone wall that is 45 feet long on the eastern and western sides and 75 feet on the other two sides. The grounds contain four rows of graves running north and south with row one on the western side and row four on the eastern side. In November 1980 eleven graves could be identified.
