CONWAY-FITZHUGH CEMETARY⁵

O. GARTH FITZHUGH

This cemetery is located near state route 230 (Wolftown-Stanardsville Road). Follow route 230 west from its intersection with U.S. 29 until it crosses Middle River (Conway River) into Greene County, then 0.4 mile to the intersection with route 667, then north on route 667 for 0.6 mile to the entrance to "Spring Hill Farm," now owned by Angus Eddins and occupied by his son James A. Eddins. The cemetery is to the left of the entrance road and 75 yards east of route 667.

NOTES

At present the cemetery has a wire fence around it. Some markers may have been lost. Two footstones marked "C.C.C." were found. Only one of these could be identified by the location and name to an individual grave. Only two headstones remain standing.

Catlett Conway, a son of Catlett Conway (1751-1827) of Orange County (Horace Edwin Hayden, Virginia Genealogies, Washington D.C., Reprint 1931, page 264)

CONWAY-FITZHUGH CEMETARY

was the first to occupy "Spring Hill," a part of the original grant of 1732 to his great grandfather, Francis Conway (1686-1732), see Nell Nugent, Cavaliers and Pioneers, Richmond, Va. 1979, Vol. 3, Page 417. The main part of the present dwelling at "Spring Hill" is the original Catlett Conway home. The will of Catlett Conway, found in Greene County Will Book I, Page 2, dated 14th April 1834 and probated 13th August 1839, mentions late wife Harriet T. Conway, daughter of Dr. Charles Taylor, and four children: William Henry Conway, Battaile F. T. Conway, Evelina T. Conway and Julia H. Conway. Catlett Conway married (1) Verlinda Taliaferro and (2) Harriet Taylor (See Hayden, page 283).

William Henry Conway married (1) 7 October 1834
Marian Glassell (ibid, page 10), and (2) Jane Fouchee
(ibid, page 283). Oscar Stuart Fitzhugh married two
daughters of Wm. H. and Marian G. Conway: (1) 14
