Maude Powell Haney & Virginia Brill Shifflett

Location: Route 33 behind George R. Haney, Sr. Garage

Survey Date: 8 December 1984

Size: 24 feet by 48 feet

Name: Robertson Cemetery

Condition: No enclosure, no monuments with names, (stones only)

Believed to be 10 graves, all names unknown

CEMETERY SURVEY

Maude Powell Haney & Daniel C. Haney

Location: On the farm now known as Farmcolony on State Route 674.

Survey Date: 3 May 1988

Name: Benjamin Franklin Powell Cemetery

Condition: Poor, although only three graves have stones, seven graves are known to be in the plot.

SELMA WARD POWELL, born April 2, 1843, died June 20, 1895 (wife)

Location: Powell's Mountain about 1-1/2 miles above the Geer Post
Office (now closed)

Survey Date: 1988

Size: 17 feet by 13 feet

Name: Edward B. Powell Cemetery

Condition: Good -- Cement wall poured in 1921

Three graves, one with marker and two with stones

All three people are of the Edward B. Powell family.

CARRIE POWELL RIDDLE, Daughter

EDWARD B. POWELL, died 1905 (Civil War Veteran, Company D, 34 VIRGINIA
