Miss Martha Virginia [Mattie] Parrott, 1848-1933, resided at "Wakefield" in southern Greene County and devoutly attended Bingham's Methodist Church near Nortonsville. Her intense interest in the events of the Methodist Church and happenings in her community prompted her to maintain records of the occurrences for her personal reference. These records are now in the possession of this contributor, Miss Mattie Parrott's grandnephew.

It should be noted that no effort has been made to corroborate this information, and it might also be noted that some of the earlier data may have been recorded by Mattie's parents, Bezaleel Brown Parrott and Julia Stephens Parrott. These records span over six decades, and are of sufficient historic quality to warrant their presentation in this volume.

Miss Mattie Parrott's records also reveal interesting bits of trivia, such as: "Had buggy repaired July, 1903; paid \$20.00 for it;" "I got gold specks May, 1903, paid \$7.00, from a pedlar, Mr. Bolling;" "Bought a cloak the fall of 1909, paid \$12.00 for it;" etc. Her family records were also extensive, but have not been included in this article.

It should be reiterated that all foregoing records from Miss Mattie Parrott's Memoranda Book are as she recorded them, with no effort toward corroboration having been made. Miss Parrott kept these extensive records for her personal reference, but the passage of of time since their recording makes them worthy of public scrutiny today.
