THE 1850 CENSUS OF GREENE COUNTY, VIRGINIA

Transcribed by Nancy H. Morris

The first official census of the United States was in 1790 although individual colonies and states conducted their own censuses, some thirty-eight of them, between 1600 and 1789. The unofficial censuses records, made at the insistence of the British Board of Trade, were used to administer the affairs of the colonies. They were usually conducted under the immediate supervision of the colonial governors, sheriffs, justices of the peace and town or county officials.

The 1850 Census was the first census taken in the United States which listed the name, age and sex of each person in the household. In previous censuses only the name of the head of the household

was recorded. In the next thirty years, the 1880 Census would include the relationship between each person listed and the head of the household, the marital status of each person and the place of birth of mother and father.

This transcription of the 1850 Census will be printed in series and this section will be the second of the series. Care has been taken to transcribe as accurately as possible the exact spelling as recorded by the enumerator. The printed copy of the 1850 Census for Greene County should save many hours of research viewing microfilm. The 1850 Census Enumerator was Jennings Maupin. All listed persons were born in Virginia unless otherwise noted. A total of 494 families and 301 farms were canvassed and listed in Greene County in 1850. The census was certified on December 31, 1850 by William L. Harris.
