

How are the Materials Returned?

Each Home Book Program mailing includes pre-paid postage. Packages can then be placed in your home mailbox for return to the library.

How Long Can I Keep the Books?

The check out period for materials is 30 days, with up to two renewals, provided there are no existing holds on the materials you wish to renew. If you have materials checked out, they will need to be returned and processed before you can receive another shipment.

What Is the Friends Home Book Program?

The Friends of the Marion Public Library fund and support the Home Book Program, which brings library services to homebound patrons. All qualified patrons can check out materials, which are then sent via mail, with prepaid return postage, at no charge.

Who is Eligible?

Temporarily or permanently homebound Marion residents (with a Marion mailing address) who have a library card in good standing from the Metro Library Network are eligible for the program.

How are Materials Selected?

Materials from the Marion Public Library's collection may be requested; eligible materials include: books, books on CD, or Playaways. Books can also be chosen for you based on preferences indicated on the application. A limit of three items may be checked out at one time.
