A WORD FROM OUR PASTOR...

The tombs were also opened, and many bodies of the saints who had fallen asleep were raised. Matthew 27:52NRSV

As I continue maximizing the ways Grace can be of service in our community, I accepted an invitation to participate in the Pastors' Prayer

for the Incarcerated on April 8th. It is not by accident that this prayer is happening during Lent season and it reminded me of an article, "Resurrection is a Movement" by Chris Hoke who is the founding director of Underground Ministries and creator of the One Paris One Prisoner Program in Washington State. Hoke wrote about his time spent as a volunteer in jail and how it changed how he viewed Holy Week. He found a parallel between the context of this text and prisoners being removed from sentencing as the "immense tombs of our days". Even if we can't relate to Hoke's story, there are other tombs in existence that has kept us bound in similar ways that leaves us grieving individually and collectively in community.

As we shift from Lent to Resurrection Sunday, I invite us to what Hoke calls a "Resurrection Movement." This movement acknowledges more than just Jesus slipping out of one burial cave on a Sunday morning but allows us to celebrate Jesus lifting others(including us) out of the tombs with Him. While the earth may not shake and literal tombs open this month, I ask that you pray with me and other pastors in Forsyth County for the men and women incarcerated in tombs and for those being released that will be returning to their friends and family. As we prepare to shout together: Christ is risen from the dead," let us become what we worship this year. Let us continue to pray for one another and celebrate resurrections from shadows and valleys we discovered during this time of reflection. Let us step into this new beginning and future together in Christ.
