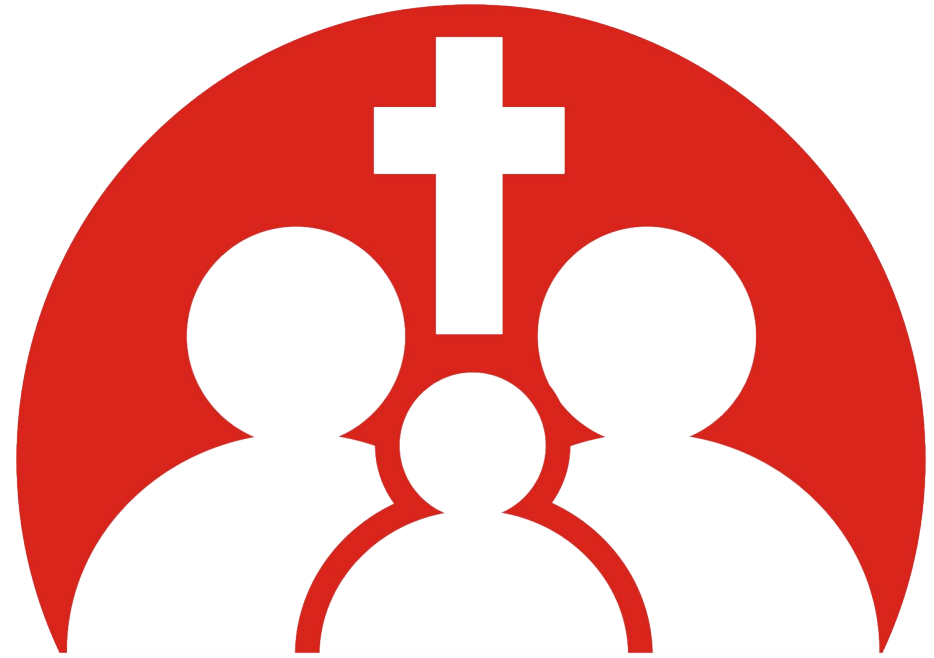

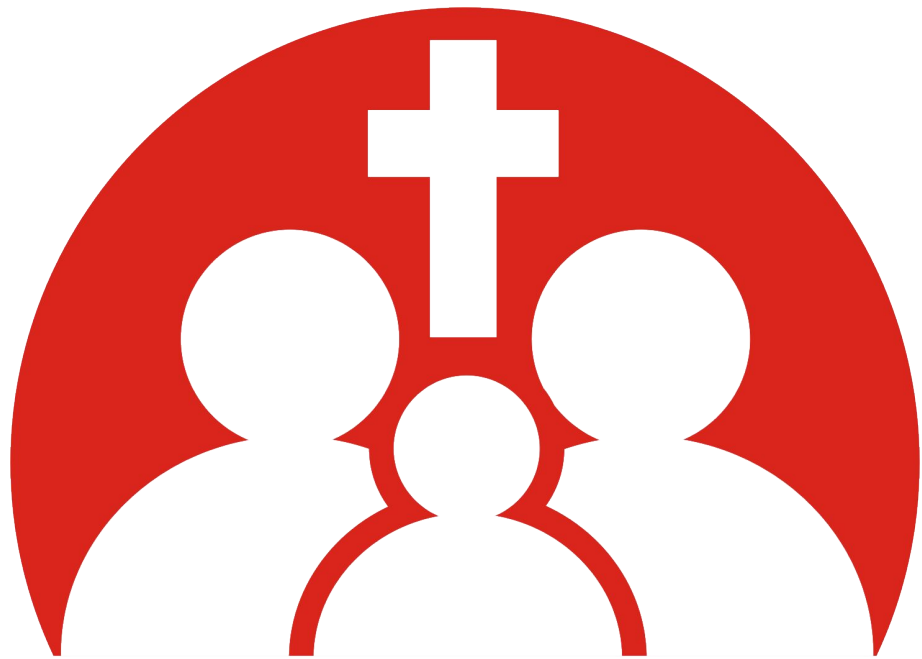

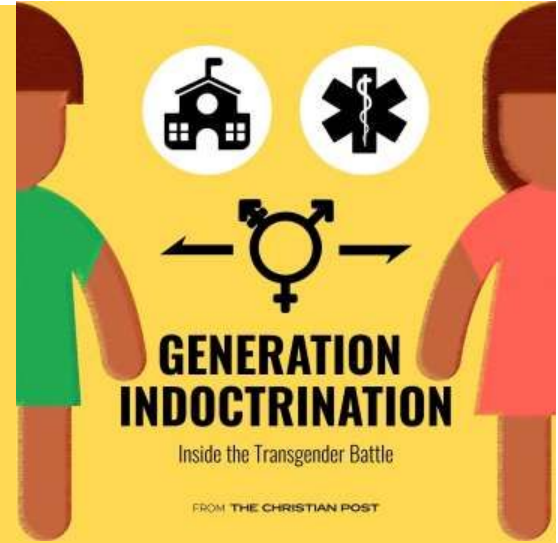

Strategies for Screen Time Balance

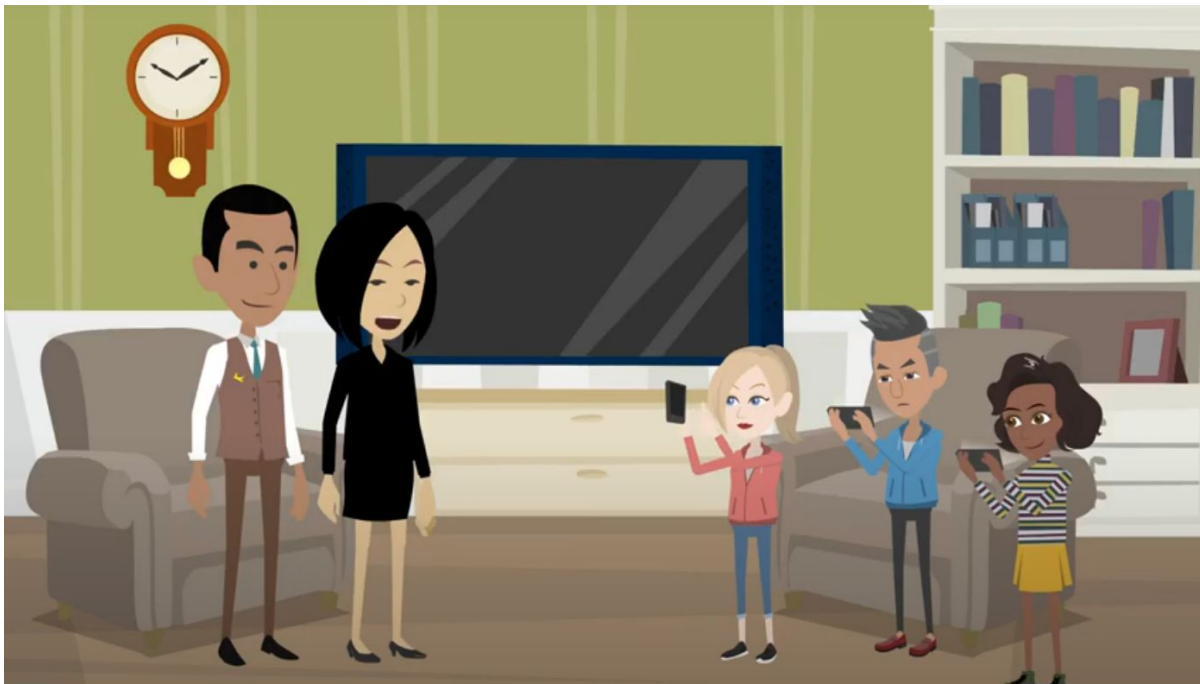

<p>The American Academy of Pediatrics recommends keeping all screens off around babies and toddlers younger than 18 months. They say a little screen time can be okay for older toddlers. Children 2 years or older should get no more than an hour of screen time per day.</p>	<p>Keep devices out of reach. Use a timer when a device is in use. Designate and limit certain times. Encourage self-play with creativity such as Legos, crafts, drawing, outside play, play-dough, etc.</p>	<p>Implement no phone zones and days, and earned time. Begin to designate times and days of use. Use screen time as an incentives for behaviors; homework, chores/responsibilities. Use screen time app. Do not allow them to be isolated with the device in their bedroom or take the device to bed.</p>	<p>Model good digital behavior, continue digital strategies and continue to be vigilant. No isolation behaviors in bedrooms, at dinner, or family time, and etc. Use screen time app.</p>	<p>Communicate your digital device boundaries for your home and family when others are in your home for your visitors to follow.</p>

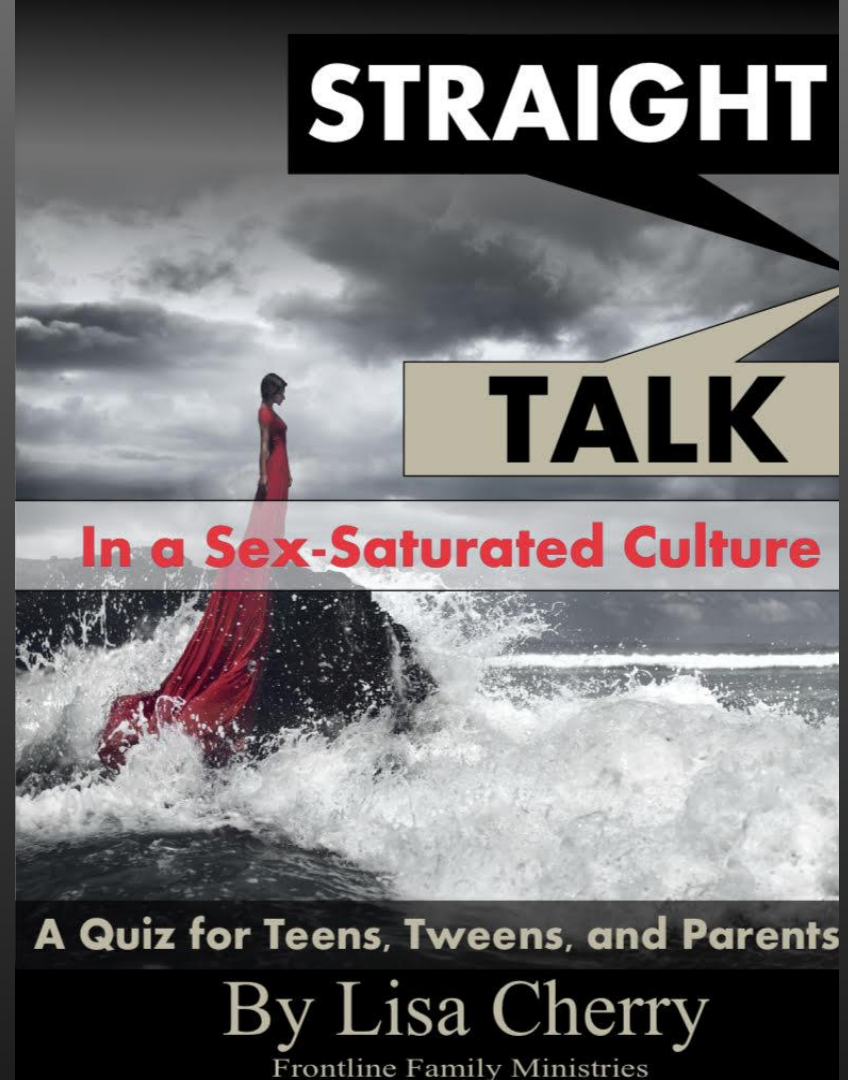




