PROVIDING SUPPORT THROUGH VOLUNTEERISM

Fair Lawn for All Ages (FLFAA) is looking to empower our students and provide them with the opportunity to help our older adult residents, veterans and mobility-challenged individuals with basic needs services. Providing an invaluable service while learning the power of giving back is the primary focus of this program.

FLFAA builds awareness and educates students about the needs of their older adult neighbors and friends. This program is the keystone to Fair Lawn's age-friendly initiative and in 2021, received congressional recognition from Representative Josh Gottheimer as well as from Bergen County Commissioner, Tracy Zur and Fair Lawn Mayor, Kurt Peluso.

FLFAA will confirm volunteer hours for faith-based or school-related community "impact" or National Honor Society requirements. Since this program is powered solely by volunteers, there is a 20 hour commitment per student, per school year. Any youth 14-18 years of age interested in joining, may register. Any graduating senior who has fulfilled their 20 hour commitment, may apply for one of two \$500 scholarships.
