“Commandments in the Classroom”: Local Faith Coalition Launches Countywide Initiative to Restore Truth and Values in Montgomery County Schools

MAGNOLIA, TX – In a bold and unified expression of faith and community partnership, Love Heals Youth, the Liberty Library Project, Lake Conroe Area Republican Women, The Woodlands Republican Women, and a growing coalition of local churches have come together to support the implementation of Senate Bill 10 (SB 10), recently passed by the 89th Texas Legislature. The new law requires the display of the Ten Commandments in every public school classroom across the state of Texas.

This grassroots, faith-driven initiative is determined to ensure that every classroom in Montgomery County is equipped with a legally compliant, high-quality, laminated Ten Commandments poster — provided at no cost to the schools or taxpayers. Each poster meets the exact legal stipulations outlined in SB 10, including proper poster size, visibility, durability, and the verbatim text from the King James Version.

“We’re coming together — not as separate organizations, but as brothers and sisters in Christ, united by a shared mission,” said Rebecca Smith, founder of Love Heals Youth.

“This is about working together as a community to restore the foundational values of truth, morality, and accountability in our schools — values that have shaped this nation and must continue to guide the next generation.”

The most recent presentation and donation offer took place at the Magnolia ISD school board meeting on Monday evening, made in partnership with Mrs. Denise Meyers. The group emphasized that this is not a single-organization campaign but a shared mission among believers—“brothers and sisters in Christ”—united in purpose.

Next Steps: Meeting Schools One by One

Organizers will continue attending district meetings across Montgomery County to present this initiative and offer donations. The campaign will remain active until every public school classroom is equipped with a poster. This is a mission of endurance and love, driven by faith and fueled by community support.

Campaign Goals:

- 10,000 posters distributed by September 1, 2025
- Coverage for every classroom across Montgomery County’s six public school districts

- Excess funds to be used for Bible donations to school libraries
