“Faith and Freedom in the Classroom: Local Groups Lead Effort to Provide Ten Commandments Posters to New Caney ISD”

New Caney, TX – In a unified and faith-driven initiative, Love Heals Youth, Liberty Library Project, The Woodlands Republican Women, and a growing coalition of local churches have come together to support New Caney ISD by donating high-quality, SB 10-compliant posters of the Ten Commandments for every classroom in the district.

During the July 21st school board meeting, Rebecca Smith-Nash spoke on behalf of the coalition, presenting a visual sample of the poster and outlining the details of the donation.

“This effort is part of a larger statewide mission to restore foundational values in Texas and Arkansas classrooms,” said Smith-Nash. “We are honored to relieve your district of this financial burden while supporting the implementation of SB 10.”

The posters meet all legal requirements outlined in Texas Senate Bill 10, passed by the 89th Legislature.

Thanks to a partnership with WallBuilders and Million Voices, over 5,000 compliant posters are currently in production. Delivery for New Caney ISD is expected within the next one to two weeks.

The posters are being provided completely free of charge to the school district and taxpayers, thanks to generous community support.
