

# WHAT TO WEAR

## BALLET/TAP ATTIRE

- black leotard
- Capezio, light pink transition tights
- Capezio/Bloch ballet shoes
- hair pulled back from face, preferably in a bun
- no ballet skirts
- Intermediate, Junior & Senior must have split sole canvas ballet shoes
- All tap shoes must be tan (Prek3, PreK4, Kinder, Beginner must have elastic fastener)



If dancer has additional classes on the day they have Ballet, They will REMAIN in black leotard and pink tights for those classes as well.

## JAZZ/ACRO/TECHNIQUE/CONTEMPORARY ATTIRE

- any color leotard with hot shorts or leggings
- any fitted dance top with black hot shorts or leggings
  - matching dance set
- dancewear MUST be fitted
- No inappropriate words, signs or signals on clothing
- tan Capezio/Bloch jazz shoes or Capezio Pirouettes



## MALE DANCERS

- black shorts, pants, leggings
- black or white tank or t-shirt
- black Capezio/Bloch ballet shoes
- Tan Capezio/Bloch tap shoes
- tan Capezio/Bloch jazz shoe or Capezio flesh tone pirouettes





## WHERE TO BUY SHOES

All shoes and tights can be purchased at Paradiddles in Lake Charles. They have a list of required shoes/styles for the Lead Dance Company. These shoes will be required for recital.

## DON'T FORGET!

- Hair should be tightly secured, away from the face; a neat bun is preferred.
- Jewelry and watches should not be worn to class.
- Any hair bow worn must be pink, black, or white (solid, or patterned)
- Dance shoes should never be worn outside.
- Dance wear is to be kept in good condition and laundered on a regular basis.
- Please label all belongings with your dancer's name.
- No baggy clothes.
- No inappropriate words, signs, or symbols on clothing.
- We reserve the rights to sit a student out of class if not dressed properly, or hair not tied.
- Prek3, Prek4, and Kindergarten levels will have occasional free dress days.
