CAMP POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

- Please keep this page for your records -

- Camp begins at 9am and ends at 2pm. The address is 4300 Sam Bass Rd, Round Rock, TX 78681, at Community Church.
- Drop-off starts at 8:15 am in the lunchroom on the East side of the building. Pick up is at 2pm in the sanctuary. Please be on time for pickup.
- We *must* know who is going to pick up your child each and every day. If it is someone other than a legal parent or guardian, we need to know who it is (full name). You should speak with the instructor or email us that information prior to pick up.
- If your student is going to leave early on any day, it is imperative that Director Adam Carney is notified before-hand of when they are to be picked up, and by whom.
- Every weekday during the last 30 minutes of camp (1:30-2:00) we are hosting a concert by different Austin area musicians! These concerts are for students to enjoy, and parents and friends are certainly encouraged to come and watch and listen. We host many amazing talents, you don't want to miss these!
- Students should bring their own lunches and snacks. Lunch is between 11:30 and 12:30. We have games and free time after lunch. We do not provide any food, and sharing is prohibited.
- We will give them all the learning materials they need for the classes and activities. That is included in tuition.
- Experienced students should bring footstools/music stands to camp. If you do not have one, we will provide one for the week. If you bring your own, please label them.
- Rarely do we experience behavioral problems. We handle it by speaking directly to the parties involved. In the case of a student who is unresponsive, the student will be isolated from the group and the parent will be called to pick up the child for the day. If the student continues to have management problems a 2nd day, the student will be expelled from camp and there will be no full or partial refund of tuition.
- For the beginner class, the student has the option to purchase a guitar and gig bag upon beginning of the camp for \$120. This is a \$200 retail value, and a great deal. If the guitar is damaged, there will not be one to replace it. We are not responsible for damage to the guitar. Once it is in the child's possession it is theirs to keep and they will be able to bring it home each day to practice.
- On Saturday we will plan a finale STUDENT performance at the Church (10am in the sanctuary). There are no classes on Saturday, only the concert.
