

Flight Lesson 13

It is important to note that this flight is conducted **AFTER** a successful Stage I flight check by the Chief Instructor or Assistant Chief Instructor.

This flight is a solo flight, but should be conducted with the instructor present on the ramp with a handheld radio. After completion of the preflight inspection the student will complete up to five acceptable take-offs and landings in the traffic pattern. If the student's knowledge of the local area and navigation skills are acceptable, the student can depart and fly in the local area. Emergency procedures and stalls are not encouraged yet.

The student and instructor should complete the post flight together.
