

Flight Lesson 9

It is important to note that this flight is conducted **AFTER** a successful Stage I flight check by the Chief Instructor or Assistant Chief Instructor.

This flight is a combination of dual flight instruction and solo flight. After completion of the preflight inspection, the flight instructor and student will complete a minimum of three acceptable take-offs and landings in the traffic pattern.

When completed and if conditions permit, the student will park the aircraft on the ramp and shut down the engine. The instructor deplanes and the student restarts the engine and performs up to five solo take-offs and landings.

At the conclusion of the flight lesson, the following should be accomplished.

1. Completed flight training folder
2. Make appropriate log book entries
3. Endorse the student's logbook and medical certificate for solo flight
4. Schedule the aircraft and instructor for the next lesson
5. Review what should be covered prior to the next
 - a. Ground review, as appropriate
 - b. Flight maneuvers review
 - c. Grade the pre-solo test and the aircraft questionnaire
