Rowlesburg Revitalization Committee (RRC) is looking for an AmeriCorps Member to serve at the Historic Rowlesburg School Szilagy Center. The town is rich in B&O Railroad and Civil War History which must be preserved and made known to local citizens. [www.rowlesburg.org](http://www.rowlesburg.org)

The successful AmeriCorps Member will develop materials to introduce and assist Rowlesburg citizens in navigating modern digital library collections from accessing a library card to accessing pertinent digitized information and knowledge. An important component of this effort will be to inform citizens of the opportunities of utilizing digital library collections in an open house setting.

Also, the successful Member will document local social, cultural, business, and industrial conditions in Rowlesburg through the eyes of prominent citizens from various time periods.

The Member may also be asked to serve as a docent in the WW II Museum, B&O Railroad Bridges Exhibit and/or the Preston County Sports Museum, as well as help stage several festivals.

A college degree or equivalent life experience is required. The applicant must have basic computer, research, writing, and communication skills.

The AFNHA AmeriCorps program provides a term of service, allowing an individual to benefit local communities & landscapes while gaining professional development & strengthening skills.

AmeriCorps members receive a \$20,000 living allowance stipend, a \$6,895 education award upon completion, and may be eligible for a WV Public Higher Education Tuition Waiver.
