TEAM RULES AND EXPECTATIONS

- 1. Please be on time and ready for practice at your assigned time. This may mean getting to the pool 5-10 minutes early to allow time to put on cap, goggles, etc.
- 2. Parents are not allowed on the pool deck during practice. Sitting under the trees or pavilion during practice is allowed but please allow the coaches to do their jobs by not interacting with your swimmer during practice unless asked to do so by a coach. Any concerns must be addressed with the coaches before or after practice.
- 3. Bullying on our team will not be tolerated. If it's a school rule then it's a pool rule! We are a team and all members are expected to respect each other. Reports of bullying will be addressed as needed and can lead up to dismissal from the team with no refund given.
- 4. Aggressive (physical or verbal) behavior toward teammates and/or coaches will not be tolerated and are grounds for immediate dismissal from the team with no refund given.
- 5. While it is not mandatory to be at every practice, regular attendance is expected in order to facilitate growth and encourage a team atmosphere. Please notify a coach if you plan to miss more than two days in a row for practice due to camps, vacations, etc.
- 6. Good sportsmanship is expected at all times, that includes parents too! We encourage a "team before the individual" mentality and work hard to keep the swim team atmosphere a positive one. Please help us by encouraging good sportsmanship at all times!
- 7. Please notify a coach ASAP if you will not be at a meet. Coaches put a lot of time into making line ups and even one "no show" swimmer can lead to a lot of extra work at the last minute for the coaches!
- 8. Weather related issues-if we need to cancel practice for bad weather we will send an email ASAP. We do practice in light rain, we CAN NOT practice during thunder or lightning. Please use your best judgment when deciding if your children are okay with practicing in "less than perfect" weather. For meets, we must show up regardless of the weather. We will attempt to wait out any storms before we postpone the meet. If meets are postponed they are most likely held on Wednesday of that same week.
- 9. It's all about FUN!!! Sometimes our practices won't look like traditional practices. Those Friday mornings spent playing Sharks and Minnows are just as important as the hardest practice of the summer. The Hills coaches love the sport of swimming and look forward to sharing their passion with the next generation!
- 10. By submitting your swim team registration your family acknowledges that they have read the above rules and agree to abide by them. As alway, the coaches have the final determination when it comes to disciplinary actions.
